

## ANTLERS OF THE MALAYAN SAMBAR

During a visit of the members of the Thailand Research Society to Nakhon Pathom I noticed a large pair of antlers of the *Malayan Sambar* (*C. unicolor equicolor equinus*) (see illustration) in the eastern Vihara of Phra Pathom. The antlers are especially remarkable owing to their extraordinarily developed brow-tines, each of which has 4 points. I have taken the measurements of the antlers, which are as follows:

<i>Length on outside curve:</i>	<i>left:</i> 31;"	<i>right:</i> 29 $\frac{3}{4}$ "
<i>Circumference at the base</i> (i. e. below the brow-tines):	<i>left:</i> 11;"	<i>right:</i> 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
<i>Tip to Tip</i>	:	18"
<i>Points:</i>	:	<i>left:</i> 6; <i>right:</i> 6
